Transaction Type/Grants to Display


- Restricted awards Select Restricted Lapse as the transaction type. Unvested grants will automatically display.
- Performance awards Select Performance Award as the transaction type. Outstanding performance awards will automatically display.

2 Select Grants to Model

- Restricted awards Select the grants you want to model and enter the quantity to model.
- Performance awards Select the grants you want to model and enter a percentage to model under "Performance %" (for awards pending achievement).

3 Enter Modeling Criteria

- Enter the estimated market price to model. The last price of the stock is provided for your information.
- Select a tax payment method, either Withhold
 Shares for Taxes or Cash Payment for Taxes
 (or other choice as provided by your company).
